6 I have a right to private and by officers of the same stripe-searched in private and by officers of the same without delay - even if I can't afford to pay.

6 I can only know why, and a right to speak privately to a lawyer to know why, and a right to speak privately to a lawyer if I am being detained or arrested, I have the right to leave unless I am being detained or arrested.

3 I can leave unless I am being detained or arrested. Saying "No" does not mean I have something to hide. If the police ask permission to search me or my things.

1 Silence (see over). 2 I can say "No".

POLICE ARREST: SILENCE IS GOLDEN

Each situation is different and you must use your common sense. Stay calm and remember everything that happens. **Remember your rights!**

① SILENCE: I can refuse to talk to police or answer their questions, unless I am in an age-restricted area (like a bar or a cinema), driving a car, or they say I broke the law. In those cases, I must give my name, birthdate and address, or show my ID, but I do not have to say any more.

If you are stopped by police against your will, give them the top part of this card and read it out. Then, **do not say anything** until you talk to a lawyer.
